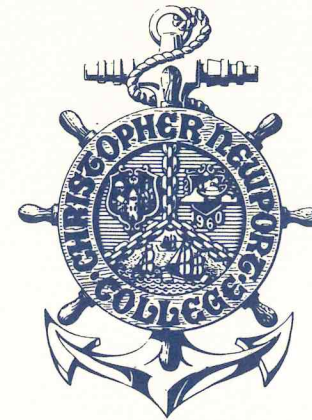

EDWARD J. CAMPBELL



Christopher Newport College is pleased to honor today Edward J. Campbell by awarding him the honorary Doctor of Laws Degree. This degree is a symbol of his life of significant service to education and society.

Edward Campbell is President and Chief Executive Officer of Newport News Shipbuilding, the nation's largest private shipyard. Newport News Shipbuilding and its subsidiary Newport News Industrial are among the central defining forces of the community out of which the College's graduates emerge; thus, the character and manner of leadership of its Chief Executive Officer are of utmost importance to the College as the Peninsula's center for undergraduate study. The life and works of Mr. Campbell have been exemplary.

Mr. Campbell joined Newport News Shipbuilding in January of 1979. He had been previously Executive Vice President of the J. I. Case Company, a Tenneco subsidiary in Racine, Wisconsin. Since 1979, Newport News Shipbuilding's sales have increased from \$730 million to \$1.627 billion; its work force has grown from 23,000 to 29,000; and its capital investment in new construction has amounted to \$371 million. Today, there is a \$7.5 billion backlog of contracts for ship construction.

Mr. Campbell's leadership has meant more than economic growth. He has encouraged the people of Newport News Shipbuilding to become active in the community's civic life. From this, the College has benefited, having two Vice Presidents serve on the Board of Visitors and the Board of Directors of the Christopher Newport College Educational Foundation, Inc. He has extended corporate support for the community's educational and cultural programs, especially the Junior Achievement program.

Mr. Campbell received both his Bachelor of Science and Master of Business Administration Degrees from Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois.

Mr. Campbell is a past chairman and current director of the Shipbuilders Council of America, Member of Council of The Society of Naval Architects and Marine Engineers, and serves on the boards of Global Marine, Inc., the National Association of Manufacturers, Sovran Financial Corporation, Hampden-Sydney College, Webb Institute of Naval Architecture, and the South-eastern Universities Research Association.

NOTE ON ACADEMIC DRESS

The history of academic dress goes back to the medieval European universities of the fourteenth century. Although European universities continue to follow varied patterns in cut and color of gown and type of headdress, the academic dress in the United States is generally standard. The gown is usually black; the pattern varies with the degrees held. The bachelor's gown is a relatively simple design, with long pointed sleeves as its distinguishing mark. The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve, with the rear part square and the front part with a cutaway arc.

The most elaborate academic costume is the doctoral gown, with velvet panels down the front, and three bars of the same material across the sleeves. The velvet may be a color designating the academic discipline to which the degree pertains, e.g., dark blue for philosophy. The hood bears a still larger symbolic burden. The width of its velvet trimmings designates the level of the degree, the color heralds the major field of learning, and its lining identifies the institution that granted the degree, e.g., Christopher Newport College is symbolized by a lining of royal blue and silver.

Certain standard colors represent the academic disciplines. The color facing the hood, like the facing on the doctoral gown, indicates the following:

White:	arts and letters including journalism
Scarlet:	theology
Purple:	law
Green:	medicine
Dark Blue:	philosophy
Yellow:	science
Brown:	architecture and the fine arts
Lilac:	dentistry
Pink:	music
Orange:	engineering
Olive:	pharmacy
Light Brown:	business
Lemon Yellow:	library science
Light Blue:	education
Peacock Blue:	international affairs
Citron Yellow:	social work
Apricot	nursing

At the discretion of the wearer, black may be substituted for any of these colors. A tassel of *metallic gold* indicates that the wearer holds a doctor's degree.
