REMINDER FOR SUPERVISORS!



It's time to conduct performance evaluations for your classified employee(s). The performance evaluation period is October 25, 2011 to October 24, 2012. All evaluations are due in Human Resources by 5:00pm, **Friday, November 2, 2012**.

Supervisors, please remember that in order to give your employee an overall rating of Extraordinary Contributor there must be at least one "Acknowledgement of Extraordinary Contribution" form on file in HR. Likewise, in order to give an employee an overall rating of Below Contributor there must be a "Notice of Improvement/Substandard Performance" form or a written notice on file in HR. Both forms must be on file and dated during the evaluation period that is currently being evaluated (10/25/11 to 10/24/12).

OPTIONAL RETIREMENT PLAN OPEN ENROLLMENT

Participants in the Optional Retirement Plan for Higher Education (ORPHE) may change providers during Open Enrollment between <u>October 1 and October 31</u>.

The two providers available are Fidelity Investments and TIAA-CREF. Administrative and investment fees vary between the two providers. An enrollment and beneficiary form or on-line registration confirmation must be completed and submitted to the Office of Human Resources unless there is an existing ORPHE account with the provider, along with the ORP Change Form. The form will be available from the Office of Human Resources in October.

Changes will be effective for ORPHE contributions sent to the new provider on or after January 1, 2013.
