Reiff Center lecture on "The World Through Arab Eyes"

The Reiff Center for Human Rights and Conflict Resolution and the World Affairs Council of Greater Hampton Roads will host a lecture by guest speaker **Dr. Shibley Telhami** titled "**The World Through Arab Eyes**," on **Thursday, March 13, 2014, at 6 p.m., in the DSU Ballroom**. The lecture is free and open to the public. No reservation is required. Telhami's most recent book *The World Through Arab Eyes: Arab Public Opinion and the Reshaping of the Middle East* will be available for purchase, and a book signing will follow the lecture.

Telhami is the Anwar Sadat Professor for Peace and Development at the University of Maryland, a nonresident senior fellow at the Saban Center at the Brookings Institution and a member of the Council on Foreign Relations. He has taught at several universities, including Cornell University, Ohio State University, University of Southern California, Princeton University, Columbia University, Swarthmore College and the University of California at Berkeley, where he earned his doctorate in political science. His best-selling book, *The Stakes: America and the Middle East* was selected by Foreign Affairs as one of the top five books on the Middle East.
