The Medieval & Renaissance Studies Fall 2016 Lecture Series continues this Thursday, October 20 at 4:30pm in the Trible Library Room 170. Dr. Charlotte Cartwright (Department of History) will be discussing "How to Read a Medieval Manuscript from a 13th Century Nunnery".

Over the summer Dr. Cartwright worked on translating a medieval manuscript. Written by hand in Latin, this document is a record of the land and wealth of the nuns of Saint Amand, a monastic house in Rouen, France.

Dr. Cartwright will explain how to read medieval handwriting, discuss the translation from Latin to English, and show how the information from the document can inform historians' understanding of the 13th century.


