## **Upcoming RAD Classes**

With the interest in R.A.D continuing to grow, we have planned more classes this semester.

For those of you who are not familiar, the R.A.D. Program is a self-defense class specifically designed to help women protect themselves against abduction and sexual assault. All R.A.D. techniques are easy to learn and are designed for individuals who have no previous self-defense experience. The program requires a 12 hour time commitment for instruction. You must attend all sessions for an instructor to certify your training.

Our first offerings will be held in January, with two different course instruction options from which to choose:

Four (4) days, with three (3) hour sessions

January 19, 21, 26, & 29

6:00-9:00 p.m.

Three (3) days, with four (4) hour sessions

January 17, 24, & 31

1:00-5:00 p.m.

What you can expect from participating in the R.A.D. classes:

- 1) To learn the profile of a potential attacker, as well as various crime prevention strategies.
- 2) To learn and develop numerous techniques used to defend against an attacker and ways to escape when presented with a threat.
- 3) To apply the learned self-defense techniques through a dynamic simulation, in which the student will complete scenario based exercises to escape a simulated attack.

These classes are open to all female students, of any physical fitness level, and they are completely FREE.

## WiFi-CNU Security Compliance Changes - CLARIFICATION about the OnGuard Software

There has been some confusion about changes to the WiFi-CNU security compliance and the request from CNU for all students to run the OnGuard client software.

The overall message is still the same. Students accessing WiFi-CNU will need to have an anti-virus software on their computer that meets the standards/expectations of CNU. This is needed to protect the network for all who use/access it. At this time, CNU is not limiting student choice of (appropriate) anti-virus software.

In order to determine if your computer has an appropriate anti-virus software installed, CNU has instructed all students to use the OnGuard Security Scanner software.

The OnGuard client software scans/checks a computer to verify certain parameters are met by the computer's software.

CNU Informational Technology Services has provided additional information at <http://cnu.edu/its/infrastructure/security%20compliance.asp>.

Here is specific information about the OnGuard Security Scanner.

What is the OnGuard Security Scanner?

The security scanner is a small file that checks a computer to verify certain parameters are met by the computer's software. It can be configured to verify the operating system and to detect whether or not most common anti-virus and firewall systems are running on a computer.

Why is CNU using this procedure?

It is best practice for the safety of all students, faculty and staff to keep their computer protected against viruses and malware. Since we all share the same network, CNU ITS requests that students help out by maintaining up to date operating systems and anti-virus on their computers.

To upload the OnGuard (scanning) software through the LINK provided, you must be on campus, using the CNU WiFi network.

When do I have to have what?

By January 4th, all students should download and run the Security Scanner on their computers. By March 1st, your computer should have an anti-virus program installed and running in order to access the network. If you already have it, your existing anti-virus program should report back healthy. CNU is not limiting student choice of anti-virus at this time.
