Notes: The usual GS Week Schedule provides for 12.75 hours of required meetings and lunches for all faculty; an additional 3.25 hours of committee meetings for returning faculty; 6.5 hours of Faculty Conference (x 2 venues); and 11 hours for Senate/Chairs/Teacher Preparation Council meetings and Honor Code orientation sessions. No time is allotted for teaching preparation. **Total allocated time:** 33.5 hours for returning faculty.

Additions and adjustments for new faculty in the usual schedule include 10.5 hours of new faculty orientation, luncheon, Banner/benefits training sessions, and teaching roundtable; less 11 hours for Senate, Chairs, Teaching Prep Council and Honor Code sessions. **Total allocated time: 33 hours for new faculty**

The proposed schedule provides for 11 hours of required meetings and lunches for all faculty; an additional 3.25 hours of committee meetings for returning faculty; 3 hours of Faculty Conference (x 4 venues); 11.5 hours for Senate/Chairs/Teacher Prep Council and Academic Day activities; and 9 hours of teaching preparation time. **Total allocated time**: **28.75 hours plus 9 hours of teaching preparation time for returning faculty.**

Additions and adjustments for new faculty include 8 hours of new faculty orientation, luncheon, Banner/benefits training sessions, teaching roundtable (held simultaneously with Honor Code Case Studies); less 3.25 hours of committee meetings and 3.5 hours of Senate/Chairs/Teacher Prep Council meetings. **Total allocated time**: **30 hours plus 9 hours of teaching preparation time for new faculty.**
