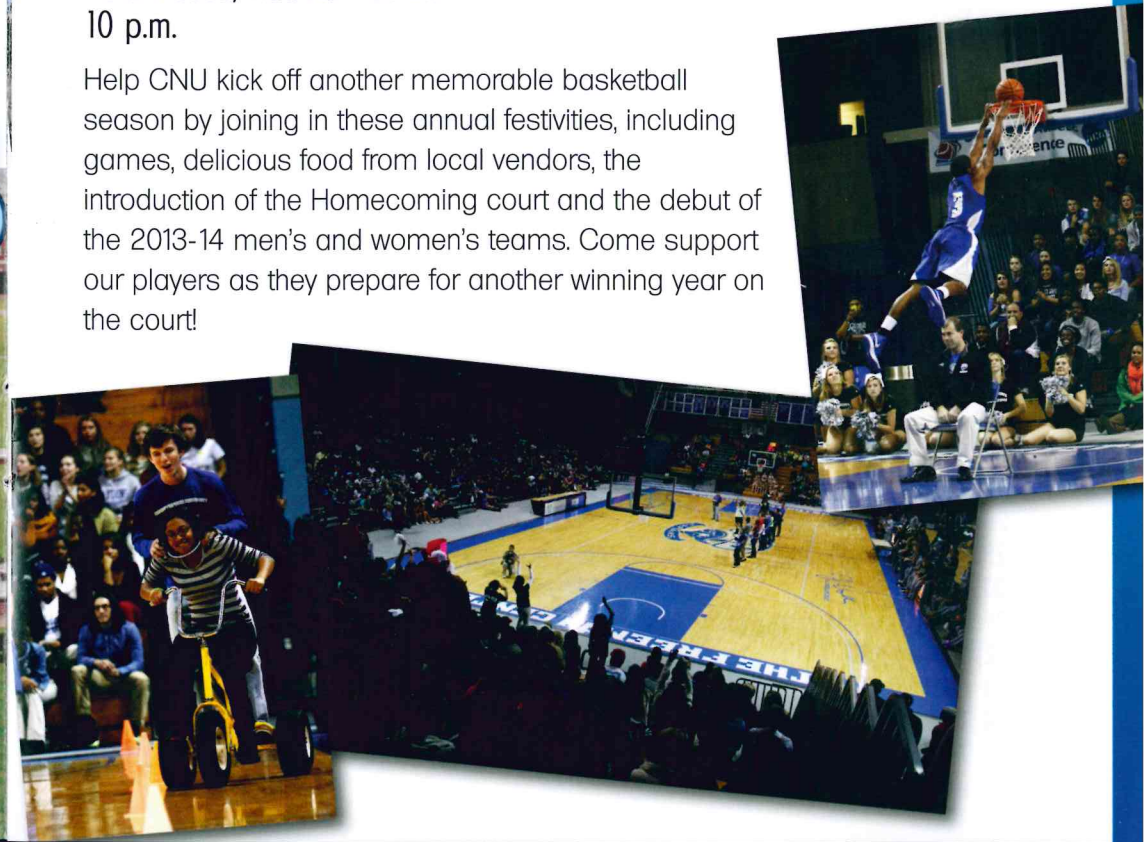

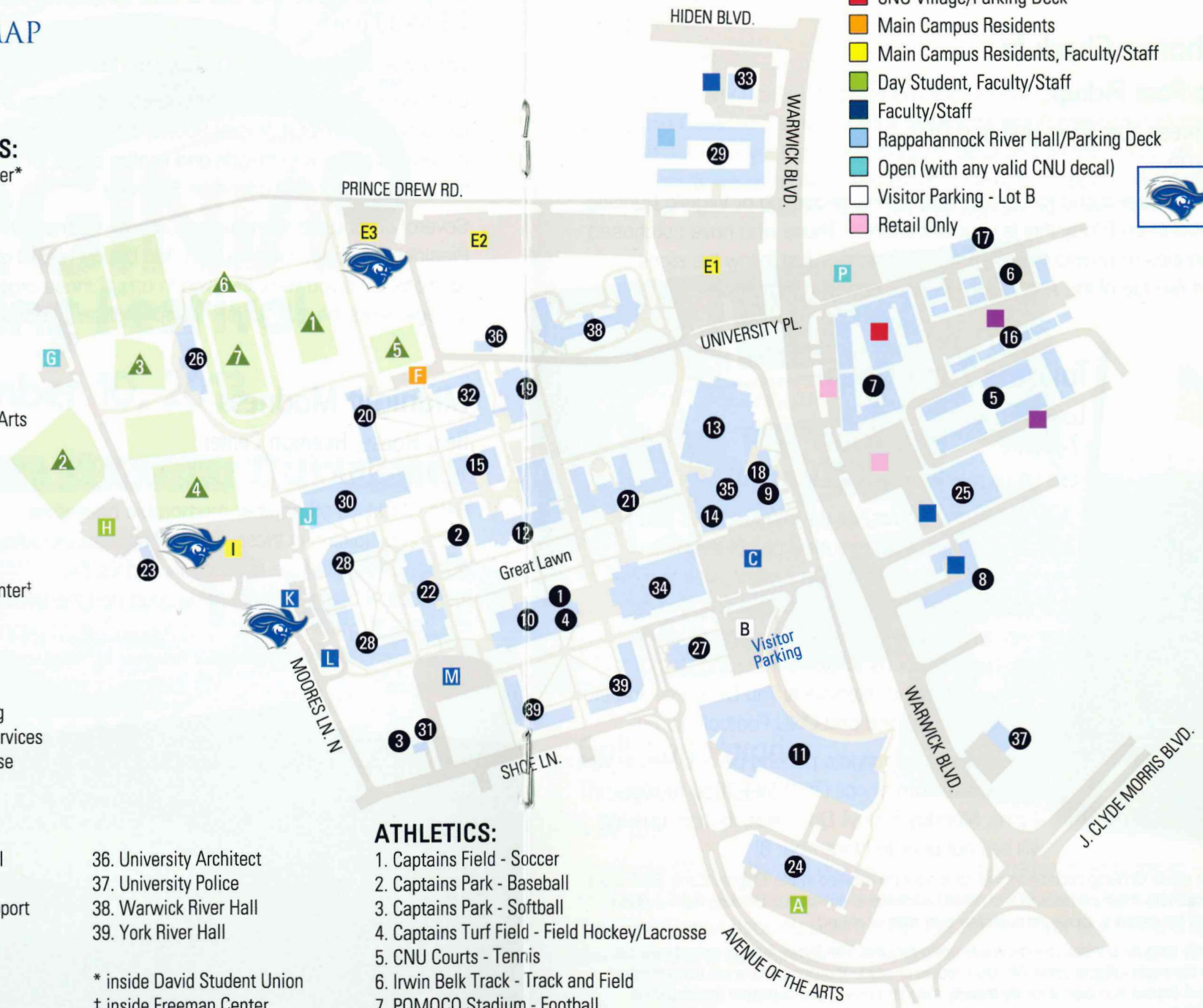

No loud music or student organizations will be permitted in this zone. A limited number of family friendly tailgate passes are available and must be requested when purchasing tailgate passes.

Virginia Running Festival Half-Marathon
