WHEREAS The Christopher Newport University School of Business was recently accredited by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business, and

WHEREAS The Christopher Newport University School of Business is one of 36 programs in the United States to earn such accreditation with only an undergraduate degree program, and

WHEREAS The School of Business was commended on the following strengths and practices:

1. The support provided by the President, Provost and a strong engaged Board of Advisors which is critical to the progress made by the school.
2. The strong faculty working as a team dedicated to achieving the University's and School's visions and missions.
3. The increasingly strong cohort of highly qualified and motivated students which is a reflection of the University's and School's selective recruiting and focused marketing.
4. The School's evolving modern business curriculum that has been updated using direct and indirect measures of assessment insights and inputs of the Board of Advisors, and best practices found at other schools and programs.
