RECIPIENT OF THE DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS DEGREE



Jean Berman Falk

Before moving to Raleigh, N.C. in 1988, Jean Berman Falk was an important Peninsula community activist and civic leader for 45 years. Her dedication to and support of numerous charitable organizations made an indelible mark on the Peninsula.

A short list of the causes she supported includes the Peninsula Home for the Aged, the American Red Cross, the Peninsula Council of the Arts, the Allied Jewish Appeal, the Virginia Opera, the Temple Sinai Sisterhood, the Jewish Community Council and the Hampton-Newport News Consolidation Study.

This commitment to betterment did not go unnoticed. In 1985, the Virginia Peninsula Chamber of Commerce named her a Distinguished Citizen.

That same year, Christopher Newport College bestowed upon her its highest honor – the Medallion of the College – for her interest and support of the performing arts program. As a major benefactor of the College, Mrs. Falk's contributions to CNC include The Emanuel E. Falk Art Gallery and an endowed music professorship in her name. She also raised a substantial amount of money to open The Cary McMurren Music Library.

Although she no longer resides on the Peninsula, her lasting contributions continue to touch the lives of so many of us.

RECIPIENT OF THE DOCTOR OF LAWS DEGREE



General Robert D. Russ (Ret.)
Commander, Tactical Air Command

General Robert D. Russ retired April 1, 1991 as Commander, Tactical Air Command after 35 years of active service in the U.S. Air Force. General Russ had led Tactical Air Command, which is based at Langley Air Force Base, since 1985. As the leader of one of the Air Force's major commands, the four-star general was responsible for more than 112,000 military and civilian people stationed at 300 locations in 20 countries.

A command pilot with more than 5,700 flying hours, he flew 242 combat missions in Vietnam, and received numerous military honors including the Distinguished Service Medal and the Silver Star.

General Russ holds a bachelor's degree in business administration from Washington State University and a master's degree in business administration from George Washington University. He is also a graduate of the Air Command and Staff College and the National War College.

He was instrumental in bringing several major weapons systems, such as the F-15 Eagle and the F-117A Stealth, into the Air Force inventory.

General Russ' leadership, however, extended beyond the gates of Langley AFB. He played important roles in several local civic and business groups, and his contributions have gone a long way in making the Virginia Peninsula a better place to live and work.

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER



James W. Dyke, Jr.
Secretary of Education
Commonwealth of Virginia

James W. Dyke, Jr. has been Virginia's Secretary of Education since January 1990. Before being appointed to the position by Governor L. Douglas Wilder, he was a partner in the Hunton & Williams law firm.

Secretary Dyke holds a B.A. and a J.D. from Howard University. While in law school, he was editor-in-chief of the Howard Law Journal.

Since graduating from law school in 1971, Secretary Dyke has held a number of prestigious positions including law clerk to Judge Spottswood W. Robinson III of the U.S. Court of Appeals, visiting professor at the University of Virginia Law School, domestic policy adviser to Vice President Walter F. Mondale and general counsel to the National Democratic Party 1976 Platform Committee.

Secretary Dyke has also held a number of professional and civic posts including memberships on the Virginia Board of Education, the Virginia-Israel Commission, the Governor's Commission on the University of the Twenty-First Century, and chairmanships of the District of Columbia Retirement Board and the District of Columbia Neighborhood Legal Services Program.

THE TRADITION OF THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

The academic costume of cap and gown worn by the faculty and students in today's commencement had its origin in the universities of the Middle Ages. Reference to exacting detail on wearing the academic costume can be found as early as 1321. Although the exact reason for the original use of the costume is not known, it is presumed that there was a very practical reason – medieval scholars probably wore the gown and hood for warmth in their unheated buildings. Students of that era wore their gowns daily, setting them apart from fellow citizens and giving rise to the term "town and gown."

In the United States, caps and gowns were worn daily by students at most American universities until the time of the Civil War. These varied in design until they were standardized by the American Intercollegiate Commission in 1894. Later guidelines on academic costume were established by the American Council on Education.

Gowns worn are generally black and the sleeves of the gown indicate the degree held by the wearer. Closed, pointed sleeves are used for the bachelor's gown; oblong sleeves, open at the wrist, for the master's gown; and bell-shaped sleeves, with three velvet bars, for the doctor's gown. The doctoral robe has full-length velvet panels in front, either black or of a color symbolizing the wearer's field of learning.

The hood is a separate ornamental fold hanging down the back of the gown. An outside band of velvet on the hood

varies in width according to the degree; two inches for the bachelor's; three for the master's; and five for the doctor's.

The color of the band and other velvet on the doctoral hood symbolize the field of learning. Standard colors are used to represent the various academic disciplines. Some of the colors that will be seen in today's ceremony indicate the following fields: **white** – arts and sciences; **scarlet** – theology; **dark blue** – philosophy; **yellow** – science; **brown** – fine arts; **pink** – music; **light brown** – business; **lemon yellow** – library science; **light blue** – education; and **peacock blue** – international affairs. The lining of the hood carries the colors of the college or university granting the degree. **Christopher Newport College** is symbolized by a lining of **royal blue and silver**. The length of the hood also varies with the degree, with the longer the hood, the more advanced the degree. Bachelor's and master's degree holders often do not wear their hoods.

The cap worn is usually the black mortarboard, decorated with a tassel which is black or a color symbolizing the field of higher learning. Gold tassels may be worn by holders of doctoral degrees, and some master's tassels are white.

Candidates for degrees frequently wear tassels on the right side of the mortarboard and then shift them to the left in unison when the degree is conferred.
