

Violations of the Honor Code

A violation of the Honor Code is a serious offense that impacts the university in two ways. First, it is a direct offense to the faculty member and to members of the class. Additionally, the violation is an affront to the University values and the ideals of CNU's Community of Honor.

Additional information regarding the Academic Honor Code Process

1. The Department Chair must be informed of the suspected violation as he/she is part of the academic appellate procedure.
2. Infractions of the Honor Code include: lying, cheating (plagiarism), stealing. Please refer to Section III, no. 2 in the University Handbook for further explanation of each.
3. Determination of a Honor Council is based on a student's prior judicial history and/or severity of the violation.
