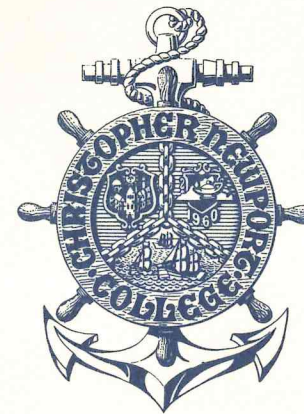

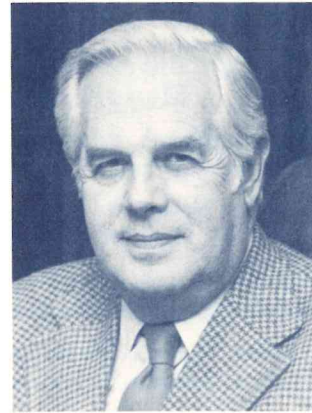

HARROL A. BRAUER, JR.

Harrol A. Brauer, Jr., appointed to the first Board of Visitors of Christopher Newport College on July 1, 1976, by Governor Mills E. Godwin, was elected by his Board colleagues to serve as the first Rector, a position to which they twice reelected him, creating six years of service in that august office. Reappointed as a Visitor by Governor John N. Dalton on July 1, 1979, Mr. Brauer completed his Board service last June. He continues to serve the interests of the College through being Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Christopher Newport College Educational Foundation, Inc., a private nonprofit philanthropic organization which he helped to create to assure the development of the College. Prior to the College's independence, he served as the Chairman of the President's Advisory Council. All together he has served the College for more than eleven years. Last year, he established the Brauer Fund from which has come the College's first endowed professorship. The Board of Visitors, in its resolution to award the Doctor of Laws Degree to him, declared that "Christopher Newport College during all her days shall reflect the thoughtful presence of Harrol A. Brauer, Jr."

Active in the field of education beyond the College, Mr. Brauer has served as member and then Chairman of the Hampton School Board and member and then Chairman of the Hampton Roads Educational Television Association. Other service roles which he has performed are Kiwanis where he has served as President and Lieutenant Governor; the American Cancer Society, for which he worked as Crusade Chairman; and St. John's Episcopal Church where he is a Lay Reader.

Born in Richmond, Virginia, and graduated from the University of Richmond, Mr. Brauer came to Hampton in the mid-forties to assume an executive position with WVEC. Retired from his radio-television vice presidency, Mr. Brauer recently reentered business by purchasing Wyatt Brothers Men's Wear. Mr. Brauer was a leader in the effort to establish a single statistical unit out of the greater Hampton Roads cities, towns and counties, to create one of the largest metropolitan marketing areas in the country.

Mr. Brauer is married to the former Elizabeth Ann Hill and they have three children—Harrol A. Brauer III, William L. Brauer, and Gregory H. Brauer, all graduates of Christopher Newport College.
