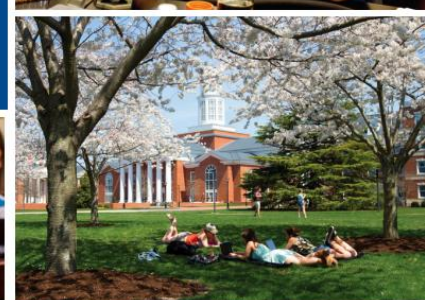

Many public colleges are so large you feel like a number rather than a person.

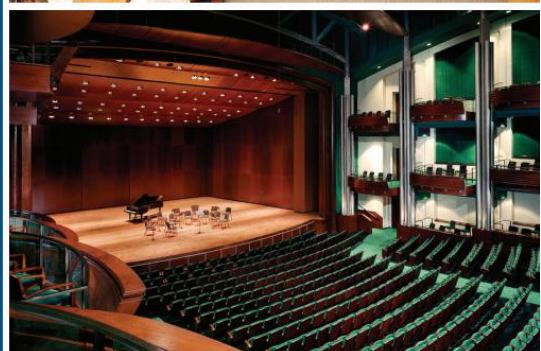
