WiFI-CNU Security Compliance - Changes in Spring 2016

Beginning March 1st of 2016, student computers accessing WiFi-CNU will be required to have anti-virus software installed and running. To ensure compliance, IT Services will use client software called OnGuard.

Student computers will be required to install this client upon returning from winter break.

However, we highly encourage you to download and install the OnGuard client available at this link (http://10.1.11.4/guest/OnGuard_HealthCheck.php?_browser=1) prior to winter break.
