There are still spots available for the May 13-25, 2014 study abroad trip to Israel and Jordan: "Ancient Israel: The Clash of Rome and Jerusalem" (CLST 370).

This 3-credit study abroad program will introduce students to the interaction of Rome and Jerusalem in the first century CE. Participants will visit Roman-era sites in Israel and Jordan in order to understand the fall of Jerusalem, the beginning of the Jewish Diaspora, and the birth of Christianity.

Highlights of the trip include visits to Jerusalem, Bethlehem, Amman; Masada, Caesarea, Qumran, Petra; the Western Wall, Church of the Holy Sepulchre, Church of the Nativity.

Program fee of \$4000 includes airfare, lodging, some meals, all entrance fees, and health insurance; CNU tuition not included.
