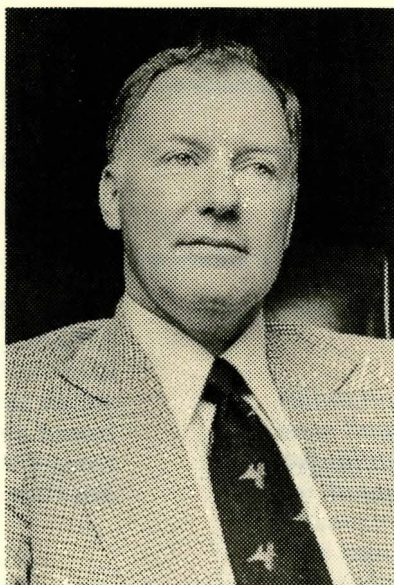

JAMES C. WINDSOR

Dr. James C. Windsor has served Christopher Newport College with distinction since September 1962 when he joined the college faculty and staff as Instructor of Psychology and Coordinator of the Evening College. He became Coordinator of the Summer Session in 1964, Dean of Student Affairs in 1965 and Director of the Counseling Center during the 1969-70 session.

Dr. Windsor assumed the duties of President of the College on July 1, 1970, and has exhibited the capacity for the most exacting executive responsibilities. He provided the leadership which enabled the college to evolve from a two-year branch of the College of William and Mary in Virginia to an independent, fully accredited senior institution of higher learning.

He has worked tirelessly to provide a rich and stimulating academic and cultural atmosphere for the college and the community it serves. Dr. Windsor is widely recognized for his scholarly competence and for his exceptional facility in human relations and has served the Board of Visitors, the administration, faculty, staff and student body with integrity.

In honor of his dedicated service and exemplary administration, the Rector and Visitors of Christopher Newport College have voted to award the Distinguished Service Medallion to Dr. James C. Windsor on the occasion of commencement exercises on May 17, 1979.
