

SENATE RESOLUTION MARCH 20, 2009

The Senate strongly recommends that the decision to notify incoming students that there will be no Social Work degree be rescinded.

Rationale: A notice to incoming students will eliminate the freshman class for the major and would, by itself, severely damage the program even without a decision to eliminate the major. Since no decision about the continuance of the Social Work major has been made or even studied, we think that sending such a notice would be both severely damaging and premature.
