Chick Corea & Béla Fleck, two master songwriters, musicians, and band leaders meet in a historic duet of piano and banjo. The Grammy-winning duet will combine Corea and Fleck's most recognizable tunes with the music from their Latin Grammy-winning album, The Enchantment, and their brand-new live album. Corea, a DownBeat Hall of Famer and NEA Jazz Master, is the fourth-most-nominated artist in Grammy Awards history, with 63 nods — and 22 wins. Chick's sound through the years has embraced straight-ahead, avant-garde, bebop, jazz-rock fusion and more. Fleck, who is often considered the world's greatest banjo player, has virtually reinvented the image and the sound of the banjo through a remarkable performing and recording career. With a mix of jazz and pop standards, crossing a myriad of genres, from jazz, bluegrass, rock, flamenco to gospel, prepare to be thoroughly entertained by two icons from different musical worlds!
