Spring Break Trip to Israel

We will have an information meeting on Wednesday September 16, from 5:45-6:45 in the McMurran 114 for those interested in a spring break trip, lasting about 10 days. Students have to be enrolled in a class associated with the trip. There are four possible classes that are associated with the trip. Each of these classes can be used to fulfill an Area of

Inquiry. The classes are: RSTD 361, Hebrew Bible, a Western Tradition; RSTD 232, Visions of Christianity, a Western Tradition; RSTD 321, Church and State, a Western Tradition; or RSTD 335, Primal Religions, a Global and Multicultural Perspectives course. If you decide to go, we will enroll you in the course of choice early. The program fee will be between \$2800 and \$3000, depending on how many students participate. It is 10 days, and the fee covers airline tickets, all hotels (which are some of the nicest in Israel), breakfast and dinner, as well as the bus all over the country.




