# MAYA ART IN THE YUCATAN



Introducing students to the culture, artistic production, and architecture of the Maya, this course provides both a historical as well as a hands-on study of principles and ideas used in art production. Dr. Morán will give lectures on cultural and artistic practices and lead tours of historical sites such as Chichen Itza, Uxmal and Mayapan. Professor Harris will lead studio projects focusing on sketchbooks and drawing assignments that incorporate the sites and artifacts studied.
