Dr. Lynn Ann Masterson, 61, of 686 Stadium Drive, Boone, passed away and went home on Thursday, Oct. 8, 2009.

She was born June 26, 1948 in Worchester, Massachusetts to Dr. James H. and Phyllis Ann Masterson.

Dr. Masterson received her PhD in Recreation Management from The University of Maryland. In addition to working professionally in the recreation and tourism industry, Dr. Masterson taught for several years in the Health, Leisure Studies, and Exercise Science department at Appalachian State University, and at Christopher Newport University as a member of the LSPE faculty from September 1, 1998, to August 31, 2003, before retiring and returning home to her beloved mountains and friends in Boone.
