RE: Charge to the committee

As a committee I ask that you work to identify meaningful steps the University should take to establish a pervasive culture of honor and integrity at Christopher Newport University. This should include the following:

1. Identify ways to accurately and clearly articulate expectations to CNU faculty, students, administrators, staff and guests.
2. Identify short term steps to be taken, beginning in fall 2007, that begin to create and define our honorable culture.
3. Identify the long term initiatives the University should undertake to infuse honor into our campus culture.
4. Outline anticipated resource needs to include financial support, human resources and physical investments.
5. Determine a system of assessment and evaluation.

This initiative will serve to define our University community for years to come and is of utmost importance. I look forward to reviewing your recommendations and ask that you provide me with your insights no later than December 1, 2007.
