Add to Academic Standing Committee Section of the Handbook
The Advisory Committee on Academic Advising (ACAA) shall consist of four faculty
members appointed by the Faculty Senate (one from Liberal Arts, one from Science and
Technology, one from Social Science and Professional Studies, and one from the School of
Business); one faculty member appointed by the Provost; one student appointed by the
Student Government Association; the Director of Academic Advising or designee (exofficio); and the Registrar or designee (ex-officio.)

The committee:

- 1. Reports to the Provost;
- 2. and makes recommendations concerning the academic advising of students to the instructional faculty or Provost as appropriate. In particular the committee:
 - a. makes recommendation and develops initiatives to clarify, assess and continually improve the advising process;
 - c. monitors the freshman advisor training program;
 - d. ensures that the academic advising system effectively serves students at different academic levels and in various situations.
