America's China and China's America: Rethinking the Past 2 1/2 Centuries



Dr. Dong Wang is professor of contemporary Chinese history and director of the Centre for East Asian Studies at the University of Turku in Finland. She is a research associate of the Fairbank Center for Chinese Studies at Harvard University and vice president of the Historical Society for Twentieth-Century China based in the U.S.

Drawing on her new book, Dr. Wang will discuss how the U.S. and China have taken root in each other – countries that became great world powers over almost two-and-a-half centuries. Wang will discuss four perceptions: the China market vs. the U.S. open door, red China vs. imperial America, the return of China vs. the allure of America and the China issue vs. the contentious hegemon.
