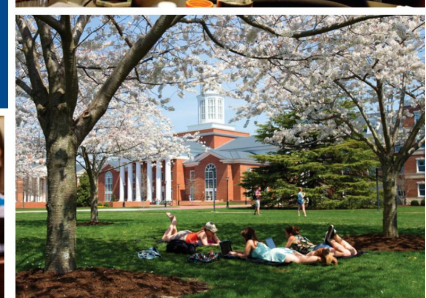


THE CNU DIFFERENCE

Christopher Newport is committed to providing extraordinary buildings that support great learning and student engagement.

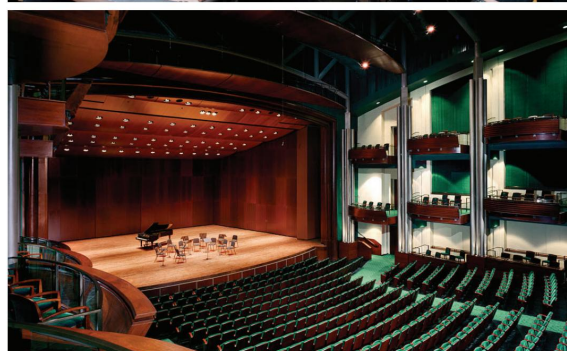

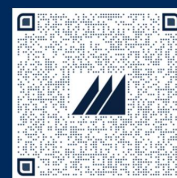
Virtual Campus TOUR
