

**PRESIDENT'S LEADERSHIP PROGRAM
STUDENT CONTRACT CLASS OF 2015**

To retain my membership and scholarship in the President's Leadership Program, I agree to the following terms:

- I will uphold the CNU Honor Code, regulations of the University, federal and state law, and I understand that any violation of these will be the cause for re-evaluation of my membership and scholarship in the President's Leadership Program.
- I will not receive my scholarship and will be asked to return it to the University if I withdraw from the President's Leadership Program or required LDSP minor classes at any given point in the semester and fail to notify the PLP office and/or fail to complete the outlined program requirements for that semester.

ACADEMIC:

- I will maintain good academic standing as a full-time student at CNU, maintaining at least the minimum cumulative GPA for my scholarship level or my scholarship may be revoked, specifically (check your scholarship level below)
 - PLP Scholar (\$1,000 per academic year) – 2.5 cumulative GPA; at no time to drop below a 2.0
 - Smithfield/Goodwin Scholar (\$2,000 per academic year) – 2.75 cumulative GPA; at no time to drop below a 2.25
 - Canon Scholar (\$5,000 per academic year) – 3.25 cumulative GPA; at no time to drop below a 2.75
- I will complete all course requirements for the academic minor in Leadership Studies.
- I will earn a passing grade (C) in both freshman-year leadership courses, LDSP 210 and LDSP 220.

INVOLVEMENT:

- I will participate in community service each year (as outlined in the PLP syllabus); to equal a minimum of 100 hours of community service over four years; a portion of the annual total must be completed **off campus** in the **local** Hampton Roads Community. Hours must be completed **during** the semester and submitted online through the Center for Community Engagement.
- I will reside on campus the first three years. If I choose to live off campus thereafter I **forfeit** my scholarship but may retain membership in the program.
 - As a Canon Scholar I will reside on campus all four years or forfeit all Canon Scholars' Program benefits.*
- I will be a contributing member of the CNU Community, through **active** involvement in at least one official campus-affiliated group, organization or athletic team each year.
- I will attend and actively participate in scheduled leadership events and planned programs, to include all visiting speakers and any program or class wide meeting sponsored by the President's Leadership Program.
- I will attend Passport Program destinations as outlined in the PLP syllabus.
- I will submit all reflections and progress reports as requested by PLP staff.

CITIZENSHIP:

- I will **self report any** University, Honor Code and/or PLP contract **violations** to the PLP Staff as soon as I am aware of the infraction.
- I will complete the appropriate steps to **make up** for any PLP contract violation I incur with the understanding that if I do not, I may be placed on **suspension and lose my PLP scholarship**.
- I will maintain courtesy and respect towards CNU professors, students, faculty and staff maintaining appropriate language and conduct in a public setting.
- I will wear business attire (Men – dress shoes, tie, dress pants, belt, dress shirt; Women – dress pants and blouse or dress/skirt and blouse, dress shoes) to President's Leadership Program-sponsored speakers and designated events (ex. Presidential receptions). I understand that I will be sent back to my room to change if not dressed appropriately.
- I recognize that I am responsible for being aware of and meeting program expectations.
- I will follow through with commitments I make to the CNU Community, PLP and its members.
- I recognize that I am responsible for being on time to PLP events and classes (meaning 5 minutes early).
- I recognize that I am responsible for staying current with PLP expectations through communication means determined by PLP Staff as well as my own efforts.
- I will contribute to the success of the program and CNU through constructive words and actions.

Failure to meet the program expectations will result in a review by the PLP Staff followed by written notice of a decision for probation, suspension or dismissal. Certain cases may require a personal meeting.
