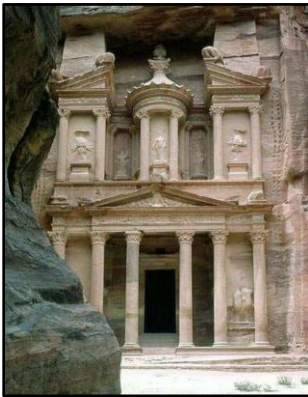


VISIT THE HOLY LAND

“Ancient Israel: The Clash of Rome and Jerusalem” (CLST 370)

May 13-25, 2014



Before Israel became the “Holy Land” for Jews, Christians, and Muslims, it was a crossroads of the ancient world. This 3-credit study abroad program will introduce students to the interaction of Rome and Jerusalem. Participants will visit Roman-era sites in Israel and Jordan in order to understand the fall of Jerusalem, the beginning of the Jewish Diaspora, and the birth of Christianity.



Cities: Jerusalem, Tel Aviv, Bethlehem, Nazareth, Amman.

Archaeological sites: Masada, Caesarea, Qumran, Petra.

Holy sites: the Western Wall, Church of the Holy Sepulchre, Church of the Nativity.

Program fee of \$4000 includes airfare, lodging, some meals, all entrance fees, and health insurance.
