Changes coming to IRB Procedures

As of August 1st, the CNU IRB will be complying with the Revised Common Rule for all applications for approval.

Some major points to note:

- 1) Exemption categories have changed
- 2) More projects will now qualify for exempt review
- 3) The exempt application has been revised and is significantly shorter
- 4) Many expedited projects will no longer require annual continuing review

To familiarize yourself with the revised common rule, the CNU IRB encourages all PIs to complete the "revised common rule" course on the CITI Program website (www.citiprogram.org).

All applications must follow the Revised Common Rule as of August 1, 2019. In person trainings will be conducted during Fall semester for those who are interested.
