Media Matter - Exploring Photoshop

The Tribble Library Media Center is offering free, 50 minute sessions, on becoming better at Photoshop. There are two parts to the instruction, but you may choose one or both.

In Part I, we'll cover the essentials and teach you how to do basic edits and then expand on the basics to enhance and fine tune images. Some working knowledge of Adobe Photoshop is suggested for this session. Part II will go into several creative aspects of using Photoshop such as creating brushes, layer masks and creation from scratch. Both sessions provided an excellent refresher for enhancing your Photoshop skills.
