<u>WEDNESDAY</u> (Veteran's <u>Day</u>): The SVO will be on hand to give out red, white, and blue ribbons as well as decorate the great lawn with flags. At 11:00 am the University will host its wreath laying ceremony and color guard/TAPS presentation. That afternoon, the SVO will be hosting a movie screening for the IVET Organization. IVET is a local organization dedicated to helping veterans overcome issues they face as they return home. The movie is called Project 22 and is about two veterans who undertake a motorcycle journey across America. Along the way they talk with other veterans about issues

they face and what alternate methods of therapy are out there. The founder of IVET, retired Brigadier General Jeff Horne will be on hand to speak and answer questions. This will take place in Forbes 1022 from 6:30 to 9:00 pm.

<u>THURSDAY</u>: The SVO will be holding a ceremony to honor students, faculty, and staff of CNU who have served in the military. This will happen in the DSU Ballroom from 12:30 TO 2:30 pm.
