Due to the closing of Lot "C" resident students have now moved to spaces in Lots "D", Lot "F", Lot "G" and Lot "N".

This means those lots will have fewer spaces available for Day (Commuter) students. Students who commute to campus should keep in mind that spaces are available in the Ferguson Center Parking Garage, Lot "A" (behind the garage) and in Lot "V" in front of the old bowling alley. Additional spaces have also been added for main campus, commuters and F/S around the old bank building at the corner of Warwick Blvd and Prince Drew Rd.

As a reminder, according to the Parking & Transportation regulations, Visitor, University Police, Reserved, Loading/Unloading and Handicapped parking spaces are restricted every day, 24 hours a day.

Shortly after graduation, construction will begin on 1,200 additional spaces along Warwick Boulevard and Prince Road and will be available this fall.
