

2014 Health Benefits Open Enrollment



Open Enrollment for the health insurance plans and flexible spending accounts is May 1, 2014 - May 23, 2013. Changes made during open enrollment will be effective on July 1, 2014. Employees will receive information from the Department of Human Resource Management (DHRM) with information on changes to the health plans and flexible spending accounts. Employees in the COVA Care or COVA HealthAware plans who were active as of March 1, 2014, should receive another letter in the mail from DHRM regarding eligibility for the Premium Rewards. Please read these communications so that you are familiar with your plan and can make informed decisions on your health plans and flexible spending accounts. Anyone who is enrolled in the health plan as of April 1 or later will receive this letter from HR. Training on these changes will be announced in future newsletters!
