Have you been out to [Payline](#) lately?

It's a helpful resource for accessing Pay History, Leave History, W-2's and more! To log on to [Payline](#), enter your State Employee Number (remember this is different than your CNU Banner ID number).

For example, for employees enrolled in the Commonwealth's health care program, the employee number begins with two zeroes (i.e., 00) followed by the seven numbers found within the ID number on the COVA Care medical benefits card (e.g., YTX1234567XU). In this case the employee number would be 001234567.

After entering your State Employee Number, enter your password. If you have forgotten your password, click on the [Forgot Password/New Account link](#). Follow the prompts for a new password to be sent to you. There are two choices for password delivery, emailed to your personal account OR to the Office of Human Resources.

Please contact the Office of Human Resources at 4-7145 if you choose for us to receive your temporary password. You can access this information from home, so memorize your Payline log on information. It's a great resource!
