GOVERNOR McDONNELL'S LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Governor Bob McDonnell recently emailed all state employees with an update regarding recent legislative developments. One of the areas discussed in the email that potentially affects some employees is the change to Virginia Retirement System benefits. House and Senate leadership reached broad agreement on a number of key matters relating to VRS to include an approved defined benefit/defined contribution combination or "hybrid" retirement plan for most newer state and local employees under VRS beginning January 1, 2014.

The Office of Human Resources awaits further details on this new benefit plan and will pass the detailed information on to the CNU Community as soon as we receive it.
