C-260 Roof Maintenance and Replacements

Working drawings were approved by the Governor on September 4, 1974. A request for bids was advertised and resulted in only one bid being submitted for an amount in excess of approved funds. A second request for bids is to be advertised.

C-261 Plans for Service Building

Preliminary drawings and specifications were submitted to the Division of Engineering and Buildings on November 8, 1974.

C-263 Storm Drainage System

Working drawings were approved by the Governor on October 1, 1974. Advertisement for bids has been held in abeyance pending resolution of legal question between the Attorney General's office and Legal Counsel of the City of Newport News School Board. Liability to be determined where drainage crosses city property enroute from Campus to Lake Maury.

C-263.1 Tennis Courts (6) (Financed from Revenue Bonds)

Working drawings were submitted to the Division of Engineering and Buildings on October 11, 1974. On October 21, 1974 by letter the Assistant Director of the Division of Engineering and Buildings suggested it would be appropriate to select a common bid advertising and opening date for both the tennis courts and storm drainage projects.

C-263. 2 Plans for Administrative Wing Addition

Authorization was received on May 16, 1974 from the Governor's office to prepare full project criteria.
