Welcome back CNU Students! To help you get off to a great start this semester, here some of our most frequently asked questions.

Question: When does my meal plan begin?

Answer: The first meal of the Fall semester will be Dinner, Sunday, August 23.

Question: When is the last day to change my meal plan?

Answer: The first day of classes is the last day to change your meal plan.

Question: Where do I go to change my meal plan?

Answer: University Housing, Christopher Newport Hall Suite #300.

Question: I only have \$50 of Dining Dollars and I paid for a 5, 10, 14 meal plan?

Answer: All students on a meal plan get \$50 the first week of school. The second week of classes the remainder will be deposited.

Fall 2015 Course Schedule Adjustment - Currently Ongoing As a reminder, please note that the Schedule Adjustment Period for FALL 2015 classes is currently ongoing and will continue until 11:59pm Friday, August 28, 2015.

Remember to check the Web Schedule of Classes often for course/section availability and prerequisites and/or registration restrictions and click on the hyperlinks for critical information regarding course description and restrictions. Students who have override forms, or must obtain an override, need to submit an Add/Drop form with appropriate signatures to the Office of the Registrar at their earliest opportunity.

Please do not forget-- the University expects students to enroll for full-time status for each fall and/or spring semester (at least 12 credits for undergraduate students and at least 9 credits for graduate students); at least 15 credits per

semester is recommended for undergraduate students for progress to graduation in four years. More than EIGHTEEN (18) credit hours in the Fall semester (to include course(s) taken elsewhere) constitutes an overload and requires students to submit a 'Request for Overload' and receive prior authorization. Note: Additional charges apply for registration over 17 credit hours during the Fall semester.

Additionally, you are strongly encouraged to view your online degree evaluation to verify your course selections. The 'Degree Evaluation' application, online via CNU Live, is an advising tool available to assist you as you meet with your advisor while making your course selections and to monitor your progress toward your degree. Not sure how to conduct the evaluation? You can find step by step instructions within the Registration Guide For Students


