## Faculty Senate Resolution – 2005-2006: 06

(as amended 3/17/06 by the Faculty Senate)

**Whereas** the tenured members of the Department of Library Science have earned and been granted tenure by Christopher Newport University through their dedication to their profession and to the institution; and

**Whereas** there may be an institutional need to eliminate the Department of Library Science while maintaining the positions and responsibilities of the faculty members within that department;

**Therefore Be It Resolved** that the two librarians with earned tenure keep their tenured status and full instructional faculty status and that the locus of their tenure be in The College Of Liberal Arts & Sciences in general rather than in a specific department; and

**Be It Further Resolved** that all Professional Librarian's contracts be changed from employees at-will to employees by contract with 3-15 month notice of non-renewal as a provision; and

**Be It Further Resolved** the Library Science courses, for which there is good demand, be moved into an existing department, or they could be made into The College Of Liberal Arts & Sciences courses which would belong to no specific department. If an accommodation like this does not happen, then University Handbook policies regarding the elimination of a program area should be followed.
