

- All courses will be off campus at a domestic or international location, and no classes will be offered on campus.
- Our target for January 2009 is approximately 5 courses.
- All students eligible to register for classes, with no financial or judicial holds on their records, may register for J-Term courses
- All January courses will be existing catalog courses. That is, no X95 (topics) or X99 (independent study) courses will be offered as January courses.
- Students may only take one January course per year. That is, no student may enroll in more than one January course at one time. (Maximum credits = 4)
- No degree conferrals will occur in J-Term, no admissions will occur, and academic standing will not be computed during J-term.
- Registration for all J-Term courses will occur via alternate pin, distributed by the Office of International Programs after students have paid program fees.
- Enrollment in all travel courses (international and domestic) will be processed through, and must be approved by, the Office of International Programs.
- The \$50.00 "Study Abroad" fee should apply to all "Study Away" and "Study Abroad" courses
- Comprehensive Fees should be waived for "Study Away" courses as they are for "Study Abroad" courses.
- The J-Term will be constructed as an independent, non-standard term like the summer terms. J-Term FTEs will be reported to SCHEV with Spring FTEs.
