### **CURRENT LANGUAGE**

f. The University Assessment and Evaluation Committee (UAEC) shall consist of the Director of Assessment and Evaluation, one representative of the student affairs staff appointed by the Dean of Students, one administrative representative from Academic Affairs appointed by the Provost, the academic deans, and four faculty members (one from Liberal Arts, one from Science and Technology, one from Social Science and Professional Studies, and one from the School of Business) appointed by the Provost.

### The UAEC:

- 1) reports to the Provost
- 2) monitors the overall operation of the assessment and evaluation program of the University; and
- 3) makes recommendations concerning changes in the assessment and evaluation program of the University.
