CNU Men's Soccer Club Constitution

The CNU Men's Soccer Club is meant to allow students who wish to play soccer competitively, but avoid varsity commitment, a chance to continue playing. It also will promote the values of commitment, teamwork, and discipline to its members.

- I. Any student regularly enrolled in Christopher Newport University may become a member of the Men's Soccer Club with voting and office-holding privileges. Dues shall vary based on financial needs of the club but should be approximately \$50 per semester. New members will not be hazed in any way. The CNU Men's soccer club shall not discriminate based on race, creed, color, sex, age, national origin, disability and sexual orientation
- II. The executive officers of the Men's Soccer Club are: President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer. The President is expected to coordinate practices and games with CNU staff and other college's clubs. The Vice-President is in a supporting role of the President. The Treasurer is expected to attend mandatory financial information meetings along with the President. The Secretary's role will be established by the President.
- III. The executive officers will work together to make sure that team events are as inclusive as possible.
- IV. Practice times will be established at the beginning of each semester. Additional practices may occur outside of normal practice times.

V.	Elections shall be held and all members will vote with equal power. Any current member
	will be eligible for one of the executive positions.
