Those interested in a Spring break 2016 trip to Israel should contact Dr. Kip Redick at kredick@cnu.edu. There is more information on the Study Abroad web site where students may fill out an application. Students will visit important sites throughout Israel and connect experiences to what they learn in the classroom. The trip will cover a wide variety of religious and cultural sites. We start in the Roman city of Caesarea by the sea, visit Mount Carmel and Nazareth. We spend three days around the Sea of Galilee and one day in the far north, visiting the ruins of Dan and the Golan Heights. On our way to the south we pass through the Jordan Valley, see the Dead Sea, and visit Qumran and Masada. We spend 4 days in and around Jerusalem, visiting archaeological digs and historical sites in the city.

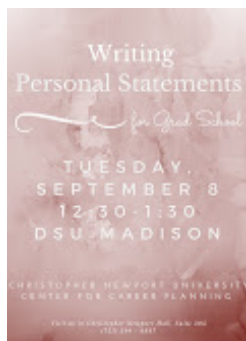
