
University Librarian's Report to CNU Faculty Senate Nov 2, 2007

University Librarian Mary Sellen discussed the addition of the Marnier's Museum Library to the Trible Library. Because the new Trible Library is so large, the only impact the Marnier's will have is on our collections and some study space.

The Marnier's collection is one of the top maritime libraries in the world. They have a significant number of rare books and maps that will enhance our liberal arts curriculum and bring scholars from around the world to CNU. It is an incredible opportunity to house such a special collection

The Marnier's Library will have the following foot print:



CNU Cataloging and Acquisitions staff who were originally scheduled to go there will be relocated to the second floor where IT services were going to go.

All of the CNU book collection will be put into compact shelving. This will give us growth room for about 10,000 more volumes. The shelving configuration will look like:
