From the producers of Food, Inc., "A Place At The Table" is an eye-opening film that looks at the food crisis in America (1 in 4 children in the US don't know where their next meal is coming from). It is a powerful film showing the struggle and pervasiveness of food insecurity happening in our country.

# PFAC Day of the Dead and Halloween Celebration

The Peninsula Fine Arts Center will host its 3rd Annual Day of the Dead celebration on Halloween this year, exploring how cultures celebrate around the world.

The Day of the Dead and Halloween Celebration will be from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Oct. 31 at the art center. Admission is free. Young attendees are encouraged to wear costumes for a costume parade in the garden. Food will be available for purchase from El Dorado, offering flautas, taquitos and gorditas.

From 12:30 to 1 p.m., dancer Ann Mazzocca will share a taste of the Day of the Dead as it is celebrated in Haiti. At 1 p.m., costumed attendees will be invited to show off their outfits and hunt for treats in our Halloween Costume Parade, to be held in the garden weather-permitting (otherwise, it will be held indoors).

Throughout the event and until 5 p.m., A Mile of Smiles will offer face painting for \$3 for children and \$5 for adults.

The Peninsula Fine Arts Center is located at 101 Museum Drive within Mariners' Museum Park in Newport News, Va. The center is open from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday and 1 to 5 p.m. Sundays; PFAC is closed on Mondays. Admission is regularly \$7.50 for adults, \$4 for children (ages 6-12) and free for children 5 and under. Annual membership is \$40 for individuals and \$60 for families.
