## CONSTITUTION OF THE RUNNING CLUB

Article 1- Name

The name of this organization shall be the Running Club at Christopher Newport University.

Article II- Purpose

The purpose of this club shall be (a) for students who enjoy running or training together with others for races of just need to stay in shape (b) to create a running community on the CNU campus (c) to increase student involvement in local Hampton Roads running races by racing or by volunteering.

Article III- Membership

Section 1. Any student regularly enrolled in Christopher Newport University may become a member of the Running Club with voting and office-holding privileges.

The standards for qualification and the amount of dues to be paid shall be determined by the club.

Section 2. Dues, having been decided on by the organization as \$20 a semester, shall be paid by members only.

Section 3. The Running Club of CNU shall not haze any prospective member for the purpose of admission into or affiliation with the organization. Members of the Running Club are free to leave or dissociate without fear of retribution or harassment. The Running Club shall not discriminate based on race, creed, color, sex, age, national origin, disability and sexual orientation.

Article IV- Executive Officers

The executive officers of the Running Club shall be as follows: President, Vice President, and Secretary/Treasurer. The aforementioned officers shall constitute the Executive Committee.
