Saturday, September 20 Excursion
to the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts

The CNU Department of History is offering a trip to Richmond to the Museum of Fine Arts on a first come first served basis to all CNU students, faculty and staff. At the museum there will be a guided tour of the ancient Egyptian, Greek, and Roman collections in the morning and a tour of the Southeast Asian collection in the afternoon. There will also be opportunities to visit the museum's other impressive collections in American history and other areas.

This trip is being led by Distinguished Professor of History and President Emeritus Dr. Anthony R. Santoro and Professor Emeritus Dr. Mario D. Mazzarella, and the Museum's Docents.

A Charter Motor Coach will depart from the parking lot behind the CNU Parking Deck at 9 a.m. on Saturday, September 20 and return to campus about 6 p.m.

There is no charge for the trip (other than a voluntary \$2.00 tip for the Motor Coach driver). The trip is open to all CNU students, faculty, and staff.

Travelers are asked to bring money for lunch at their own expense at the Museum Cafeteria or at the Mediterranean Delicatessen and Bakery in Richmond.

As there are certain to be fewer seats available than interested travelers, interested parties must email Dr. Santoro at santoro@cnu.edu giving their full name, their CNU ID number, their CNU email address, and their cell telephone number, complete with area code.

Applicants will be notified by email either way on whether space is available for the excursion.
