"Prayers for Bobby" is based off the true story of Bobby Griffith, a teenage homosexual male raised in a traditional Christian household in the late 1970s and early 1980s. When Bobby came out as gay to his family, his mother, Mary Griffith (played by Sigourney Weaver), attempted to change his sexuality through teachings of the Bible. What followed was a tragic struggle of faith and sexuality between mother and son (prayersforbobby.com).

A panel discussion will follow about the relationship between religion and sexuality as depicted via film. This event is FREE and open to the public, but a ticket is required to gain entry.
