Colleagues,

I share news of the passing of Dr. James Irwin Moore, Professor Emeritus of Computer Science, on May 23, 2012.

The following information has been reported to me from multiple sources. I sincerely regret if there is any inaccurate information included, but I wanted to sent out a message in a timely fashion. It is my understanding that an obit is forthcoming in the newspaper.

The funeral service is scheduled for June 4 at Grace United Methodist Church, where he was an active member and continued to attend until close to his death.

Dr. Moore served on the faculty at CNU from from 1971 to 1997. Dr. Moore first taught in the Department of Government, and then transitioned to offering instruction in computer science in the current Department of Physics, Computer Science and

Engineering. Gosnold 123, where CPSC110 was taught for years, was named the James I. Moore classroom, in honor of his design of the instructional space. He also served in a key administrative role in Academic Affairs.

Dr. Moore served in the Navy, and had a scholarly interest in the history of Pearl Harbor.

He earned the B.S. from the United States Naval Postgraduate School, and the M.A.P.A.

and Ph.D. from the University of Oklahoma.

Dr. Moore was highly engaged with the Life Long Learners, an association which he helped to start.
