# Constitution of Cnu Ice Hockey Adopted 2024 Revised 2024 Organization Founded 2002

### **Article I: Name**

The name of this organization shall be CNU Men's Ice Hockey,
Also known as CNU Ice Hockey.

## **Article II: Purpose**

The purpose of this organization shall be to give young men a chance to continue their Ice Hockey career.

# **Article III: Membership**

# **Section 1: Eligibility**

Membership in this organization shall be open to anyone willing to make a big time commitment and who has previous experience playing Ice Hockey.

# **Section 2: Dues**

Members shall be required to pay dues in the amount of 1900. Failure to pay dues may result in loss of membership privileges.

### **Article IV: Officers**

Officers shall serve a term of one year and may be eligible for re-election.

### **Article V: Meetings**

# **Section 1: General Meetings**

General meetings of the organization shall be held once a month. All members are encouraged to attend.

# **Section 2: Special Meetings**

Special meetings may be called by the President, Vice President or upon written request of 35% of members.

### **Article VI: Removal of Members**

# **Section 1: Grounds for Removal**

Members may be removed from the organization for the following reasons: Violating the school code of conduct or failure to meet membership obligations.

The removal of a member shall follow the following procedure:

- 1. A written complaint must be filed with the President or Vice President.
- 2. The accused member shall be provided with a copy of the complaint and be given an opportunity to respond.
- 3. Eboard shall review the complaint and the member's response and make a final determination.
- 4. If removal is warranted, the member shall be notified in writing and provided with an opportunity to appeal the decision.

### Article VII: Removal of Advisor

### **Section 1: Grounds for Removal**

### **Article VIII: Amendments**

This constitution may be amended by a 66% vote of the general membership. Proposed amendments must be submitted in writing at least two weeks prior to the vote.

### **Article IX: Non-Discrimination Clause**

"Discrimination against any individual based upon protected status, which is defined as age, color, disability, gender identity or expression, national origin, race, religion, sex, sexual orientation, or veteran status is prohibited.

### **Article X: Dissolution**

In the event of the dissolution of this organization, any remaining assets shall be distributed money divided up and distributed back to players and all remaining assets shall be donated to a hockey charity.

# **Article XI: Ratification**

This constitution shall be ratified by a 75% Vote
