Dr. Teschner has taught on a full and part-time basis at Bloomfield College, Bloomfield, New Jersey, since 1967 as a lecturer, instructor, and assistant professor. His teaching covered a wide range of courses including Introduction to Philosophy, Ethics, Existentialism, Logic, Philosophy of Science, Greek Philosophy, Medieval Philosophy, Modern Philosophy, Nineteenth Century Philosophy, Recent and Contemporary Philosophy, Indian Philosophy, Chinese Philosophy, Comparative Eastern and Western Philosophy, and Philosophy in Primitive Societies. Dr. Teschner has been very active at Bloomfield College as an advisor to the national honor fraternity in Philosophy (Phi Sigma Tau) and as the Director of the College Philosophy Forum. Dr. Teschner's dissertation was a phenomenological analysis of the meaning of God for man in the philosophy of Kierkegaard.
