

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO ATTEND EVENING COLLEGE?

Any qualified G. E. D. high school graduate or college student who can submit the enclosed Certificate of Good Standing.

#### HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Fifteen dollars per credit hour (i.e., English 101, 3 credits, \$45) plus cost of books. There are no other fees. Check should be made payable to CHRISTOPHER NEWPORT COLLEGE.

#### ARE TRANSCRIPTS REQUIRED TO COMPLETE ENROLLMENT?

Only for those students entering a degree program or hoping to complete their degree requirements at CHRIS-TOPHER NEWPORT COLLEGE. All other students will need a copy of the enclosed CERTIFICATE OF GOOD STANDING from the high school or college last attended or a copy of the G. E. D.

#### HOW CAN AN APPLICANT ENROLL IN THE EVENING COLLEGE?

Either by MAIL or in PERSON at the Evening College Office, Room 102, Christopher Newport Hall—8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Mailing address: Evening College, Christopher Newport College, P. O. Box 1518, Newport News, Virginia, 23601. THE OFFICE IS OPEN ON MONDAY EVENING OF EACH WEEK FROM 6-9 p.m. CLOSED ON SATURDAYS.

#### HOW DOES AN APPLICANT ENROLL?

EITHER BY MAIL OR IN PERSON:

- 1. Send Certificate of Good Standing to proper authority as soon as possible.
- 2. Complete the proper application form.
- 3. Mail, or bring in person, check and application form to the Evening College Office.

REGISTRATION NIGHT WILL BE HELD WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 31, 1968 IN RATCLIFFE HALL FOM 6-9 p.m.

ALL STUDENTS WILL RECEIVE AN ACCEPTANCE LETTER SENT FROM THE EVENING COLLEGE OFFICE.

NEW STUDENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED **CONDITIONALLY** UNTIL AN ACCEPTABLE CERTIFICATE OF GOOD STANDING HAS BEEN RECEIVED IN THE EVENING COLLEGE OFFICE. AT THAT TIME, THEY WILL BE CHANGED TO FULL ACCEPTANCE. NO GRADE OR CREDITS WILL BE GIVEN TO STUDENTS WHO DO NOT HAVE A CERTIFICATE OF GOOD STANDING ON FILE BY THE END OF THE SEMESTER.

THE EVENING COLLEGE OPERATES THREE SESSIONS: FALL, SPRING AND SUMMER. A SEPARATE ANNOUNCEMENT WILL BE PREPARED FOR EACH SESSION. WRITE OR CALL THE OFFICE FOR INFORMATION ABOUT COURSE OFFERINGS; TELEPHONE 596-7611, EXT. 46 OR 47. COLLEGE BULLETINS WILL BE SENT UPON REQUEST.
