The LSU College Readiness Program

Abstract: The LSU College Readiness Program for Math reaches daily over 5,000 Louisiana middle and high school students. Its goal is to help them to be better prepared for success in college by

- \* exposing them to the rigor and requirements of first year college math courses while they are still in the safe confines of the high school, and
- \* providing them with background math content needed to be successful in these first year math college courses.

This talk will describe the set-up of this self-sustaining, financially autonomous program that also supports a variety of student-centered outreach initiatives and teacher professional development programs.
